Enjoy our beautiful scenic one mile walking trail through the woods. Dogs are welcome to enjoy it too. The park also offers 6 tennis courts open to the public, baseball fields, basketball court and a sand volleyball court. A children's Play Area is in the center of the park with swings and other things to play on. There are also plenty of outdoor grills to have a picnic in the park. There are 2 separate restroom facilities, one next to the baseball fields and the other at the Park Office. The Park Office will be open in the summer every day until 4pm. Stop in to pick up additional information on all park activities going on throughout the summer. Park Office phone number is (724) 652-8842.

There are 6 covered picnic shelters that can be rented for family picnics, birthday party celebrations, family reunions or just to have a day at the park. Each shelter has multiple picnic tables, electric outlets and lights. Call the Neshannock Township building for information on which shelter is available for you. The Hutchison Center is an Indoor facility that can be rented for Wedding receptions, Graduation Parties, Birthday Parties or any group function or get together. This building has a kitchen area with a large oven with grill top and 6 burners. It also has a very large refrigerator and stand up freezer.
